STAMFORD HOSPITAL

As ever the Hospital remains busy with very high patient satisfaction reports. The Peterborough and Stamford Hospital NHS Foundation Trust board has recently ratified the plans to develop the site, including the sale of half the land. The proposed development looks encouraging and this time it looks that it might really



happen. There is concern about the sale of half the land which seems to many to be short sighted and will limit the opportunities for expansion of services in the future. There are covenants on the land which limits its use and if it is sold it hopefully will remain part of a “health care campus”. We will watch with interest and be pleased to express the views of our members, so please let us know what you think. The AGM is a good opportunity for that.

There was a very good turn out and we all learnt a lot from a fascinating account.

It makes such a difference to a visit to the Hospital when one is greeted by a smiling, helpful person. They also raise a lot of money for us through the book sales, so please keep the books coming, and you can always bring those you buy back again to be resold.
