The Future of Stamford Hospital.

The Peterborough and Stamford Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust is committed to retain services at the hospital, and has made impressive investments in medical and other equipment, some of which has also been supported with funds from the Friends. It is clear that the provision of hospital care has changed greatly in recent years throughout the country and Stamford Hospital has to adapt. The Friends policy is to show a keen interest in developments at the hospital and offer support for any new initiatives, whilst questioning any changes that might undermine the future [happily at present there seem to be none of these].

The Town Council is also showing considerable interest in the Hospital and is represented at the regular meetings of senior management at the hospital.

Allocated Funds.

Our main target last year was to provide funds to support the modernisation of gastrointestinal endoscopy equipment. I am pleased to report that this has been purchased and the Hospital now has the very latest "state of the art" equipment. Our contribution of £12,000 was a fraction of the total cost and it is reassuring to see the Trust management being prepared to invest over £100,000.

We have also supported a number of smaller items such as lamps for the out patient clinics and funds to support new facilities for the hard working medical secretarial staff. Our next target is to pay for a "Molemate", equipment that will be used in the dermatology clinic to improve the distinction between benign and malignant moles.
