Dear Friends,

Stamford Hospital remains very busy. The figures show that in 2013 there was a total of 105,233 patient attendances, and this year the figure is likely to be 10% higher. There are many areas that are thriving, not least the minor injuries unit (MIU) where there are rising attendances and a remarkably high patient satisfaction rating. It may be that the opening hours of the MIU will be extended, including into weekends. The John van Geest unit remains busy, providing a most valued inpatient service for local people. Attendances in the out patient department may reach 40,000 this year, and there is a wide range of clinics provided.

The Hospital remains a very popular place to work and continues to attract large numbers of applicants for any vacancies. We are fortunate to have such good staff and the Friends do all we can to support them.

Thanks to the generosity of members of the Friends, to legacies, to book sales and to other donations we continue to raise substantial sums of money to support the Hospital, and we have supported a number of purchases in recent months.. information about the Friends. We have also provided funds for a much needed refurbishment of the visitors' room on the Van Geest ward, and this has been greatly appreciated.

The plans for the redevelopment of the Hospital's site are proceeding slowly. All the indications are that these plans will be fulfilled, and we hope to play a significant role by providing funds to support new and innovative services. Hence at present we are limiting our spending and building up a "treasure chest" which will be used as soon as the developments proceed. We will continue to work to raise more funds and we are confident that these will be put to good use.
